Because of this, we want to make sure project applicants and consultants have a clear idea of how the programming process will work once applications are all in. Back to the Hyperloop....

Now that all projects have been programmed, we go back to Crystal Lake Ave Hyperloop. As mentioned, it can't go in its requested year, 2021. It can't go in 2022, because there is no available funding there either. There IS money left in 2023. As a result, it'll go there.

If there was no money left in 2023, then the project would have to be put on the contingency list.

While rank is indeed important, we are subject to the fiscal constraint of that year. A lower-ranked project that requests an out-year may have a better likelihood of getting funded than a higher-ranked project in an earlier, more requested year. It is important to think carefully about when the best year for your project is. While we would love to accommodate all projects in 2021, that is not possible under Active Program Management.
