### 1. CALL TO ORDER

### 3. **MPI CONTRACT UPDATE – ERIK MORIMOTO**

### 4. **OPEN DISCUSSION**

Mr. Morimoto opened the floor up to discussion. He proposed that the group have a biweekly conference call every other Tuesday at 2:30 PM, with the next call on November 10. Please contact him or Ms. Skowronski if you would like to join.

Ms. Skowronski explained that McHenry County has seen an increase in cases.

Mr. Morimoto explained that Cary was now going back to split shifts, with part of their staff working Monday, Wednesday, and every other Friday and part of their staff working Tuesday, Thursday, and every other Friday, 10 hours a day. Staff are also on call during days off.

Ms. Skowronski noted that the DOT has not had a positive COVID test. Mr. Markison said that the DOT meets with Lake, Kane, and DuPage Counties regularly to discuss COVID and that the DOT has plans in place in the event of positive cases. An example of this is that the DOT could go from their usual 20 snow plow routes to 8.
