Good Morning Group:

I am reaching out to you today as a follow-up from the MPI group meeting held in Glenview a few months back and your interest in participating in a joint bid for pavement rejuvenation. As was highlighted at that meeting many communities are beginning to work with a firm called "Corrective Asphalt Materials" or CAM. Rachel Lang is the main point of contact in Illinois for CAM and she has been working most recently with Kane County and McHenry County Transportation and most recently the Village of Winnetka in the Northshore area. CAM offers many various products which I am sure Rachel would be happy to provide to the group however the product that this joint agreement would be for is Reclamite. I have provided a copy of the brochure for this product and the SDS Sheet; for those communities that have a ban on coal tar cased products this product meets that ban.

I am working with Rachel right now on preparing a more formal proposal for their services however I need to gather a little data from each on the anticipated dollar allocation for this contract. This product is typically paid on average at an all-in price of \$0.82 a SY. This includes resident notifications, traffic control, application of product, sand casting and cleaning. This product is typically applied within one year of the resurfacing work taking place. The Village of Winnetka is anticipating on allocating approximately 20k towards the application of this product on roadways that are resurfaced this year, and a couple from last year.

Please note that because of the characteristics of the material, that being an emulsion based product, this would be a sole source product; this means that the service and product will not be bid out to multiple vendors. My goal is to get a formal proposal for the MPI group by March 1st. Because there are so many communities that are interested in this product, and because each of our communities have different paving schedules I would anticipate that each community would coordinate directly with Rachel as to when this work is performed.

Please let me know if you have any questions if not please forward along to me your anticipated fiscal commitment to this program for 2016.
