Dundee Avenue Reconstruction

The proposed Dundee Avenue improvement will consist of the reconstruction of the existing bituminous pavement, which is deteriorating and in need of full replacement. As part of the reconstruction the existing utilities which are in need of repair will be replaced or rehabilitated, existing curb and gutter will be removed and replaced, bituminous asphalt roadway pavement will be reconstructed to provide a wider four-lane section throughout, and new 5' wide sidewalk will be installed. A new storm sewer system will also be constructed which will tie into the existing storm sewer at both ends of the project, significantly decreasing intersection and pavement flooding.

Dundee Avenue provides an important regional and intra-city, north/south route located in the northeast area of the City of Elgin. This facility effectively provides a high-volume, four-lane arterial connection from downtown Elgin northwards to the Jane Addams Memorial Tollway (I-90) and northward to the McHenry County communities of Algonquin, Crystal Lake, Cary, and Lake in the Hills. Dundee Avenue provides safe and efficient movement of vehicle trips which originate within the City of Elgin as well as through movements from vehicles with trips originating outside of the City of Elgin.

The project is scheduled for construction in FY 2024, and has received funding commitments from the Kane County Council of Mayors and the City of Elgin.
