




# Introduction: Where We Are Today







## What Is Required Under the ADA



### What is Required?

#### All public entities <u>must:</u>

- Conduct self-evaluations
- Provide public notice about the ADA requirements



### What Is Required?

Public entities with 50 or more employees have additional requirements:

- Designate an ADA Coordinator
- Establish a grievance procedure
- Develop and implement a transition plan




